All the manuscripts must be written in English and should be prepared in given style by ICACT bureau. All submitted papers will be reviewed by the global reviewers & technical paper finalizing TFT team. For the review, all the papers in PDF should be submitted to the ICACT2012 conference website (<http://www.icact.org>), filling every item and uploading the respective papers.

After you win the acceptance notification, you have to prepare the final camera-ready manuscript of maximum six(6) IEEE double-column formatted pages, the Copyright Transfer Agreement, and the Speaker's Biography together.
